*Special shuttle service from New Castle to Pittsburgh-
Thursday, April 23rd and Friday, April 24th*

**Here is some important information to help
guide you:**

- There will be 4 shuttle buses available for both Thursday and Friday for the Draft. Please see schedule for times and stop locations.
- The fare is \$4.00 per person per trip.
- The drop-off and pick-up location in Pittsburgh will be at the Ross Park and Ride located adjacent to the Perry Highway exit ramp on I-279. From there, PRT will operate a free shuttle service "99N Football Flyer" to take commuters to the event. This shuttle will operate on 15 minute intervals. - Our regular Route 71 Pittsburgh buses will still operate on normal schedule.
- If you plan to ride our regular Route 71 Pittsburgh buses to attend the draft, the PRT Route 99E (free of charge) can be caught at the East Busway at the Penn Station- Gate C stop and will transfer you to the north side. You can also catch the subway at Steel Plaza and ride for free to the North side.
